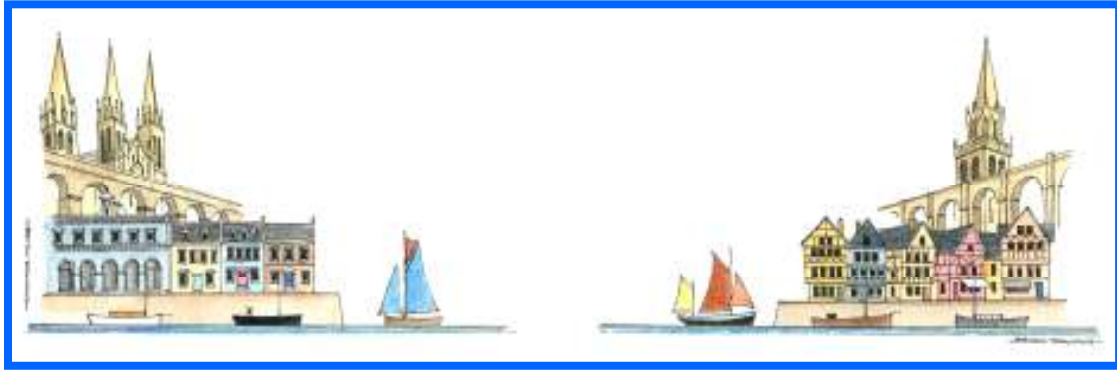


TWIN LINK JUNE 2010
